The Chadwick Center for Children and Families at Rady Children's Hospital- San Diego, is one of the largest hospital-based Children's Advocacy Centers and trauma treatment centers in the nation. We provide family-focused and trauma-informed services to children and adolescents who may have experienced or witnessed maltreatment, abuse, or violence.

KidSTART Clinic is a synergistic outpatient behavioral health program that serves young children aged 0-5 with complex social-emotional, behavioral, and developmental needs and their caregivers. The program is funded by the County of San Diego, Behavioral Health Services. KidSTART Clinic provides comprehensive assessment and treatment services. Evidence-based practices and evidence-informed treatments focus on trauma-informed infant and early childhood mental health and include the Caregiver Wellness Program to address caregiver needs while their child is in treatment.

The KidSTART Clinic Program Manager is responsible for the oversight & daily operations of the program, supervision of the team, and compliance with funder requirements for the program. They report to the Chadwick Center Trauma PEI Initiatives Manager.

Please note that the position is titled Program Supervisor within the RCHSD system but is a Program Manager position within the context of San Diego County BHS.

Minimum requirements are BBS licensure as LMFT, LCSW, or LPCC; experience with supervising clinical staff; expertise in early childhood mental health; and utilization of diversity-informed practices. Preferred experience with EPSDT/County contract programs.
